

Animal Control Barking Dog Log



Please read the instructions for this log carefully!

For a citation to be issued to the dog owner you must keep a log of the barking or noise. You must provide an address and be able to visibly see the dog/dogs. A description of the dog barking is required. An additional recording or video of the barking/noise is also required. The dog or dogs must bark or make disturbing noise including howling, barking, or whining for 10 consecutive minutes or intermittent episodes lasting a minimum of 30 minutes which causes an unreasonable annoyance. A person making a complaint must be willing to keep an accurate log of the disturbance and submit the log as required by the Animal Control Deputy. If the barking or noise is caused by the presence of predators, deer, or other provocation the dog may not be considered an annoyance. Please use the chart below to log the activity. You need to be willing to appear in court in order to sign a complaint.

ORS 162.375 INITIATING A FALSE REPORT:

- (1) A person commits a crime of initiating a false report if the person knowingly initiates a false alarm or report, which is transmitted to a fire department, law enforcement agency, or other organization that deals with emergencies involving danger to life or property.
- (2) A person who violates this section commits a class A misdemeanor.
